Keyn's perforated pattern adds textural depth, further distinguishing the design and contributing to its lightweight aesthetic. It also adds aeration in the backrest.



Keyn can be bold and playful or sophisticated and subdued, allowing it to find a home anywhere from the meeting room to the cafeteria to a private office.
