



Getting Collaboration Right




Sabha Collaborative Seating[™] was born out of the realisation that teamwork and collaborative events are intrinsic to the success of the world's top companies.




Sabha is the ultimate soft-seating system. Designed to be lightweight, low and open-platform, it can be configured in myriad ways. According to Wang, modularity was a key consideration in the design for Sabha. 








Sabha's modular kit of parts can be configured to create a variety of individual and group settings to support a range of activities – from creating and contemplating to conversing and sharing.








